## Today's lessons:

- Ezekiel 34:11-16, 20-24     Because the leaders of Israel have proved to be incompetent to shepherd their flock, God promises that he himself will take care of them, get rid of the bullies and look after the injured.
- Psalm 100     Psalm 100 can be read as an answer to God's promise from Ezekiel 34.
- Ephesians 1:15-23     God has put Jesus Christ in charge over all the world.
- Matthew 25:31-46     In the end Jesus Christ will return as King of all the world. Then he will decide who belongs to him and who doesn't.

## Did you know:



The festival of 'Christ the King', also called 'The Reign of Christ', is the last Sunday of the Church Year. It brings the yearly cycle that began with the preparation for the birth of Jesus Christ to a conclusion: we celebrate that Christ now rules forever.

Next Sunday we begin the new year with the First Sunday of Advent. And we also change to a different Gospel book then: up to this Sunday we have been reading Matthew, now we are switching to Mark.
