

Instructions for In-Person Worship Service

These measures are being taken out of an abundance of caution. We are striving to make in person worship safe and meaningful for all.

Here is what you need to know for in-person worship services:

- Please arrive no earlier than 8:45am
- Good Shepherd strongly advises being doubly vaccinated, if possible
- Please review the COVID19 screening checklist prior to leaving home
- **Park in church lot and use that entrance** (Caledon St. door will be locked);
- **Masking and physical distancing must be observed at all times in the building**
- You will be greeted by the contact tracer/covid screener in the foyer
- Please keep all coats, hats, mitts etc. with you
- Seating will be available in *every other pew* to help ensure physical distancing of 2 meters/6ft between households
- Offering plate will be on the altar
- Service will be on power point; there will be no printed materials
- Singing is permitted (with masks on)
- Washrooms are available for use
- No coffee after service – please visit outside the building
- Please **leave the building at the conclusion of worship**; we know that visiting is essential to our community's well-being, but for the time being it must be done outside
